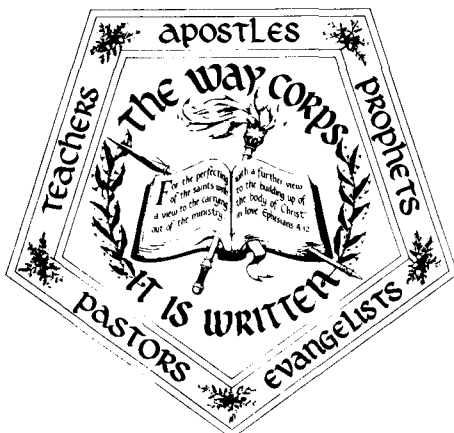

Three to Get Ready...


One of the busiest places on grounds at LIVING VICTORIOUSLY is backstage behind The Way Big Top Auditorium. The backstage area is noticeably calm, considering all that goes on there and the rather small quarters. According to Billy Britt, the overall coordinator, approximately 130 people pass through backstage preparation each night.

Laura Ellenwood, who coordinates hair, make-up and wardrobe said, "Our job is to take care of the physical needs so all that the teachers and performers have to think about is what they have to do out there." Not only teachers, vocalists and dancers, but orchestra musicians and the believers who will manifest on stage are prepped by the backstage crew.

The area is divided into rooms: a trustee office; Dr. Wierwille's office; a performers' lounge; a teachers' lounge; an emcee working area, its walls plastered with schedules for Main Stage; two mirrored areas for hair and make-up; and two dressing rooms.

One of Monday's teachers, Rev. Jim Lowry, said, "It's more detailed than any television studio I've been in. Not only do they really take care of the people, but they also take time to listen to the Word that's being taught."

One of the most important things going on backstage is prayer. Before each session of the class, everyone involved gathers backstage to pray and believe for what is about to happen—that it might be the best for God's people.
