

#### YOU CAN'T MAKE ME DOUBT HIM

The other night Rosanne O'Hara, Way Corps 10, was in her RV, fellowshipping with other believers, when a pot full of boiling water slipped off the ledge above her, covering her arms and stomach with its contents.

To see her less than 24 hours later, you'd hardly believe the incident had occurred. Where there should have been scarred, blistered skin, only a slight discoloration remained, along with a bruise where the pot had hit her arm.

"The believers there ministered to me immediately," Rosanne shared, "and put ice on me to lessen the pain. Throughout the night I kept feeding my mind with the positives of the Word and believing images of victory. I pictured myself climbing the rocks at LEAD, playing volleyball, anything that required the use of my arms.

"I asked God to heal me, but He told me I was healed when I was ministered to; that any pain that remained was merely a symptom, and that it was false. The next morning there were no blisters, and I felt no worse than if I had been sunburned. I went to Third Aid, and they told me my healing was a miracle.

"I was really mad at the Devil for trying to stop me from speaking the Word, so I went out that day and talked to as many people as possible, ministering to needs and telling them about The Way Corps. It's important to speak for God. No matter what the Adversary tries to throw at me, God will continue to meet my needs."
