ROCK TWIGS MEET

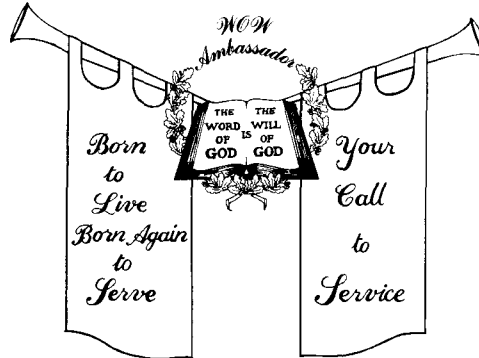

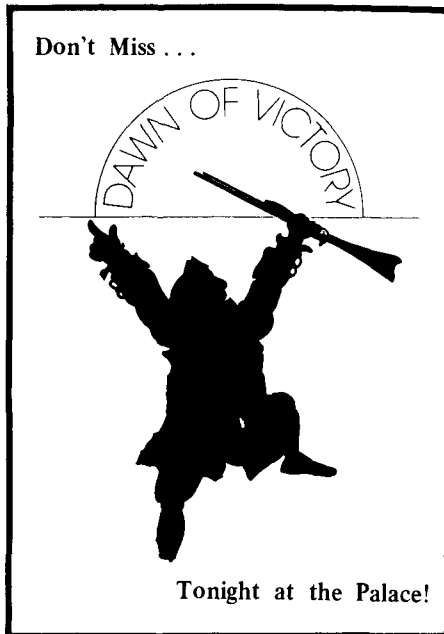

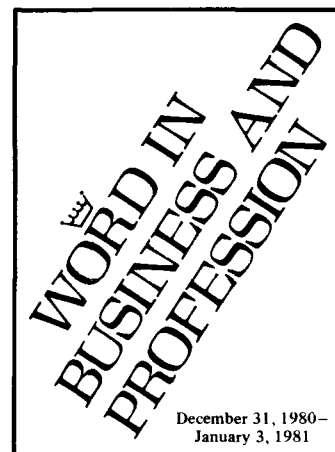
