"In Matthew 22, Jesus Christ proclaimed the first and great commandment to be to love God with all your heart, soul, and mind," said Dr. Wierwille early in his teaching Tuesday night, *God's Call to Love Others*. "And the second is like unto it, love your neighbor as yourself."

"It's still a question in most people's minds: Who is my neighbor? That is the question I am going to answer for you tonight," he continued. "The teaching in the world today is the fatherhood of God and the brotherhood of man. It's not true. God is only the Father of those He has fathered."

"Who is my neighbor? My neighbor is a fellow believer. If he is born again of God's spirit, then it is my responsibility to care for him, no matter how immature. I fight for you, believe for you, pray for you, stand with you. I love you. I don't care about your background or what you have done. I'll give my life for you, for you are my neighbor."

Time Shortens for WOW Sign-ups

Processing for new WOW Ambassadors closes tonight at midnight, and '81-'82 WOWs who answered the WOW calling at Rock of Ages '81 are urged to have their counseling finished by 12:00 midnight. WOW candidates who did not enroll in the program before the Rock of Ages '81 pre-registration deadline should report to The Way of the USA Pavilion as soon as possible to fill out applications and speak with a WOW counselor.

Rev. Willie Sisneros, on duty at the WOW Processing Center, said that WOW candidates who still need finances should register, complete their applications and essays and then get their money together, rather than wait until they have their expense money before registering.

"I just want to get them in," said Rev. Sisneros. "If they did their counseling and application, it would boost their believing tremendously. Some people wonder if they will have time to go on a second wave later. A second WOW wave is not even a consideration as far as I'm concerned."

WOW Vet-A Lifetime of Service

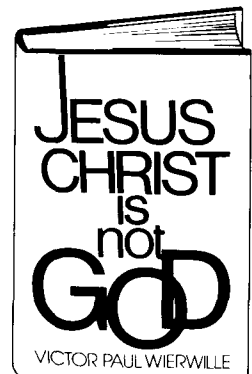
