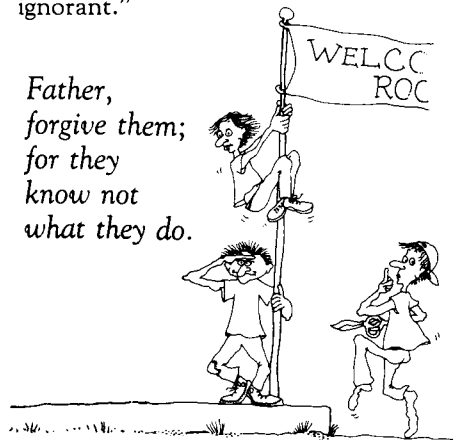
It's a Small-minded World!
