"To the end you put on his mind up here and you know his mind from the Word, you get renewed."

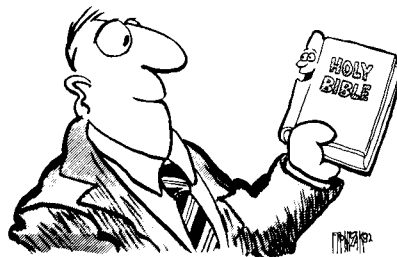

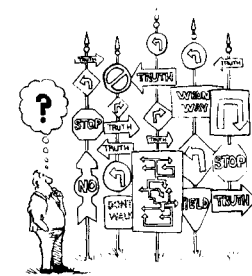
