OUTREACH ATHLETES

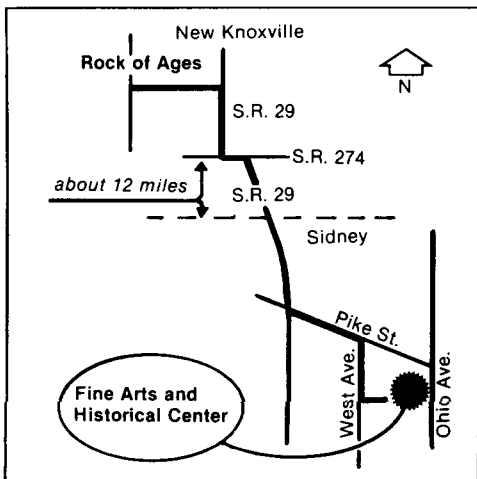

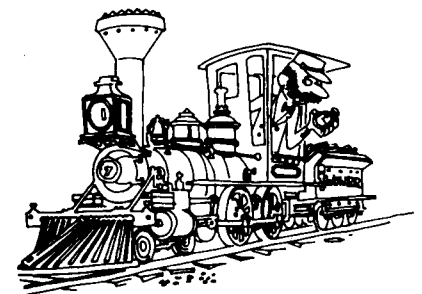
Adult Pavilion

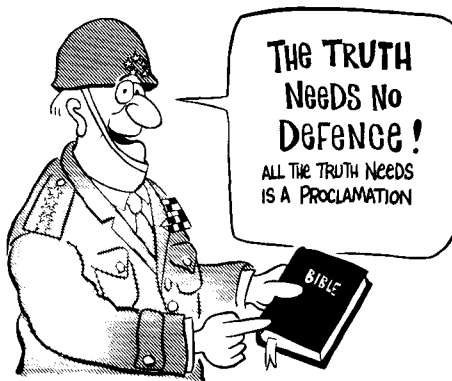

Behind the Scenes

As you leave The Way Big Top
 Auditorium each evening, audio
 engineers are already preparing the
 teaching tape that will be duplicated
 overnight. Decisions are made concern-
 ing what to include on each
 tape, and a master tape is sent to
 the Tape Duplicating Department in
 the Outreach Services Center. There,
 high-speed duplicators and cassette
 loaders clatter through the night as
 each 90-minute tape is recorded and
 loaded into a cassette shell in little
 more than two minutes.

 are ready for purchase at the ROA
 Tape Sales Tent.
