If you're held by the Word, you've got to go and you've just got to tell!

Many times God's call to send someone is unsettling to that person. But it's God's call and He doesn't make mistakes.

You've got to be at peace with God and have His peace reigning in your mind to speak. He delivers you so you *can* speak.






"Oh, I'm Camping"

"Tent City" breeds unique arrangements. The Pfeifles, who are Twig coordinators, and their three children sleep together in one main tent. Outside the tent is a large canopy, surrounded by three smaller tents which house eight believers in their Twig. The canopy serves as the living room area, where the Twig meets for prayer, occasional meals and fellowship.

Jyseppi and Mike met because their tents are close to each other and they discovered that they are both professional musicians. For them, the virtues of tent-living include: "the constant opportunity to meet people that you'd never meet anywhere else. You hear believers talking outside your tent and it becomes so easy to meet the needs of total strangers."

Everyone agrees that the closeness to other believers, the proximity to "nature" and the sharing of lives makes "Tent City" a very special place at the Rock of Ages.
