The answers to all of life are there in God's Word. So it's our joy as students to find them. There's effort and there is work involved in finding them.

I thank God that Dr. Wierwille had questions—things that he was concerned with, things about which he doubted.

Dr. Wierwille's commitment was to go to the Word.

Don't be ashamed of questions. Your questions give you a direction for your growth.

There is no increase without God, and there's no planting and watering without us. We're workers together. We need each other.

We need to continue to work together. We are fellow laborers with God and with each other. If we disagree, we go back to the Word of God, and the Word of God has to fit. If it's God's Word, it has to be perfect.

You know something ninety-nine percent of the world doesn't know. That percentage is going down because you keep speaking the Word.

As long as it makes a difference to you if you're abased or abounding, you're limited. You're too conservative. You're not going to hold forth the Word.

"I can do." We need to keep driving that in our minds. We need to become "I can do" people.

How should you move the Word over the world? The Word tells you to do it heartily. Do it with thy might—that's the standard.
