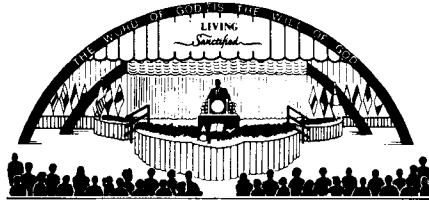
SHARE FULLY WITH YOUR TWIG

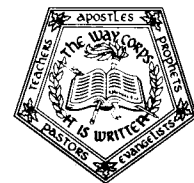

Rocky Mountain Region

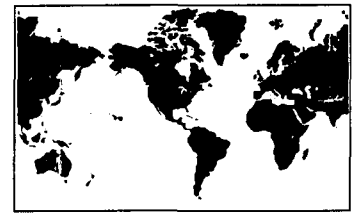
