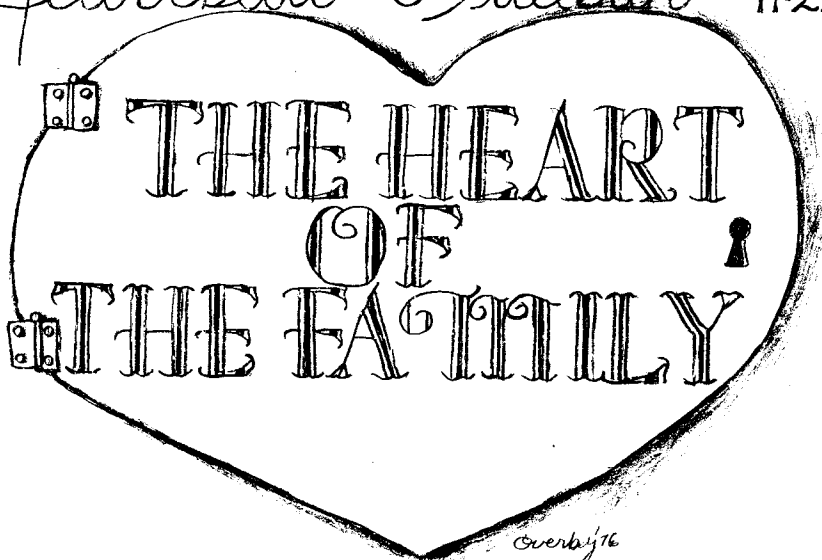

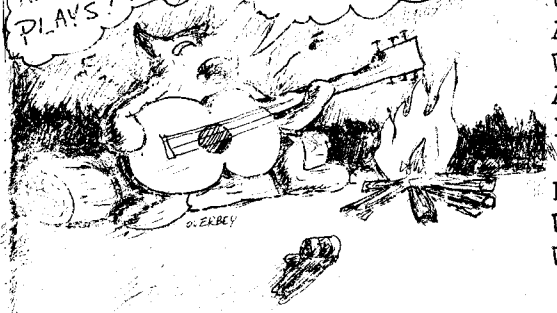
"We still play around too much; we still want temporal things. God is your sufficiency and you have to learn to set your affections on things above." Rev. Del Duncan
