That Jesus had in mind.

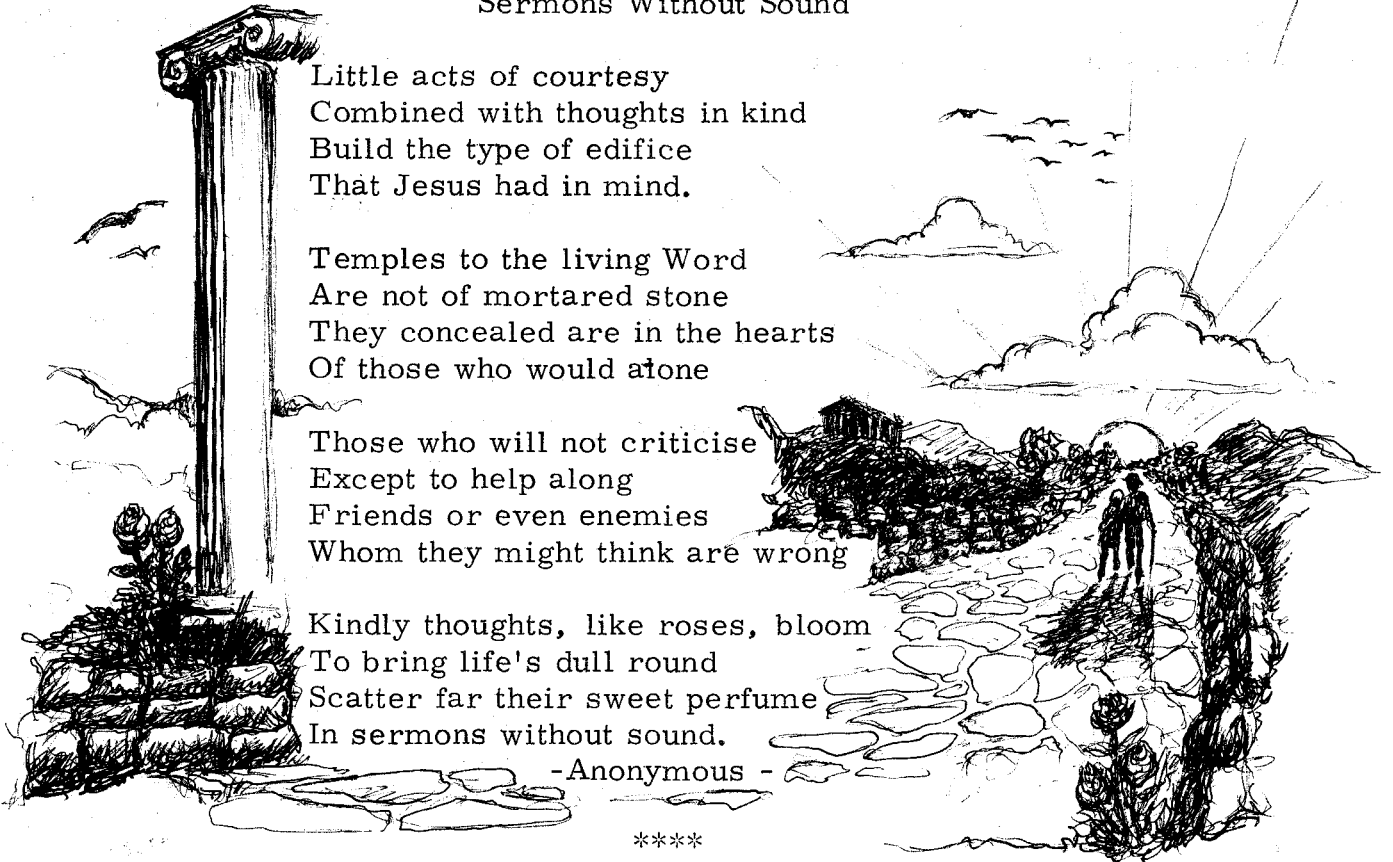
Temples to the living Word
