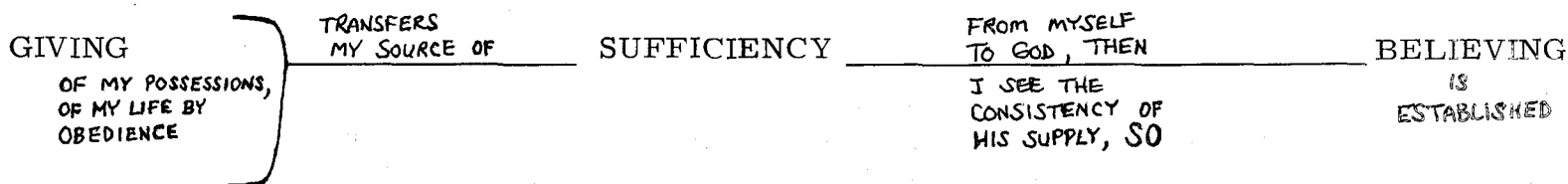

 As the Word moves over the land

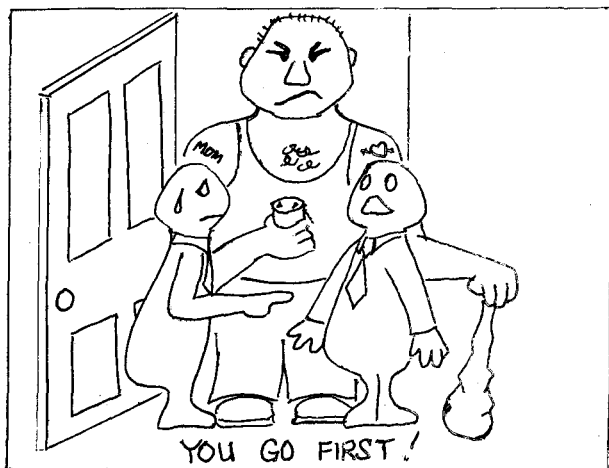
