Goal: They'll obey from the heart.

Proverbs 29:17 Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea he shall give delight unto thy soul.

Be long on praise and short on criticism.

Undershepherding is a mom raising her children.

Reproof often means to reprove with words. You don't always have to swing the spoon. Sometimes you do, but you don't always have to.

Children are a blessing, not a hindrance.

The child's only responsibility is to obey their parents in the Lord. Ephesians 6:1-3

Obey parents today - obey God tomorrow.
