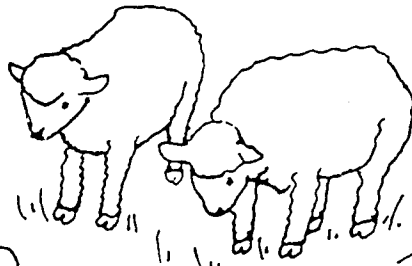
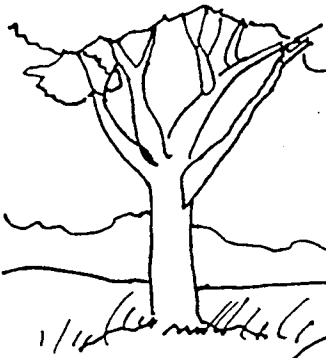


Singing to God with a Thankful Heart!
