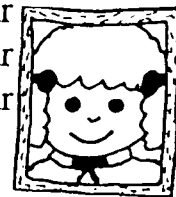


Christ in You!



Look at your hands! They are part of your body. Okay, now look at your feet! You may have shoes on, but you know you have feet. They are part of your body, too. If you look in a mirror, you will see your eyes, your mouth, and your nose! They are part of your body, too. You know you have a body!



Now, clap your hands! Stomp your feet! Blink your eyes, open your mouth and now, breathe through your nose! Why can you do those things with your body? You have life in your body! It's called breath-life or soul. Your soul makes your body alive because you can breathe. When you have soul, you can play, work, eat, believe, and do many things.

Some people only have a body and a soul for their entire lives. God wants you to have much more than that! He wants you to have what He is inside of you. He wants you to belong to Him. God is spirit. You cannot see spirit so you cannot see God. God is called the Holy Spirit. He wants you to have holy spirit in you! Then you can have body, soul, and spirit! Do you know how super, super, super holy spirit is? Wow! It is perfect! It is power! It is love! It is everything that God is in Christ! Christ is in heaven with God his Father and you are here, but you can have God in Christ in you! When you have holy spirit, then you have Christ in you! That makes you very, very special. You belong to God.

When you have body, soul, and spirit, then you have nothing missing. You are complete. You are whole, not just part. It is called being saved. To be saved means to be made whole or complete with nothing missing. When you have holy spirit or Christ in you, you are saved - you belong to God.

God's Word tells you how to get saved. It's simple. Listen to Romans 10:9:

**That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord
Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath
raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.**

Remember how God raised up Jesus Christ from the dead to never die again? That is proof that he is the Son of God. He is the greatest person that you could ever obey. He is the lord that God wants us to have. Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus. Okay, let's do it. Say, "Jesus, you are Lord in my life." That's wonderful. Now, the second part is not with your mouth. It is believing that God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now, can you believe that God raised Jesus Christ from the dead? Sure you can! Remember how Jesus Christ was crucified and dead and buried for three days and three nights, and then God raised him up and made him alive? God has great power. He did that! Believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead. Then, guess what! You are saved! You have holy spirit in you!

That is Christ in you! You believed! You see, what God did in Christ, then Christ worked in you when you believed. That makes you God's son or child. He is your Father. Listen to I John 3:2a:

Beloved, now are we the sons of God,...

Isn't that wonderful? We are sons now!

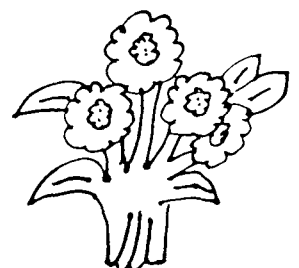
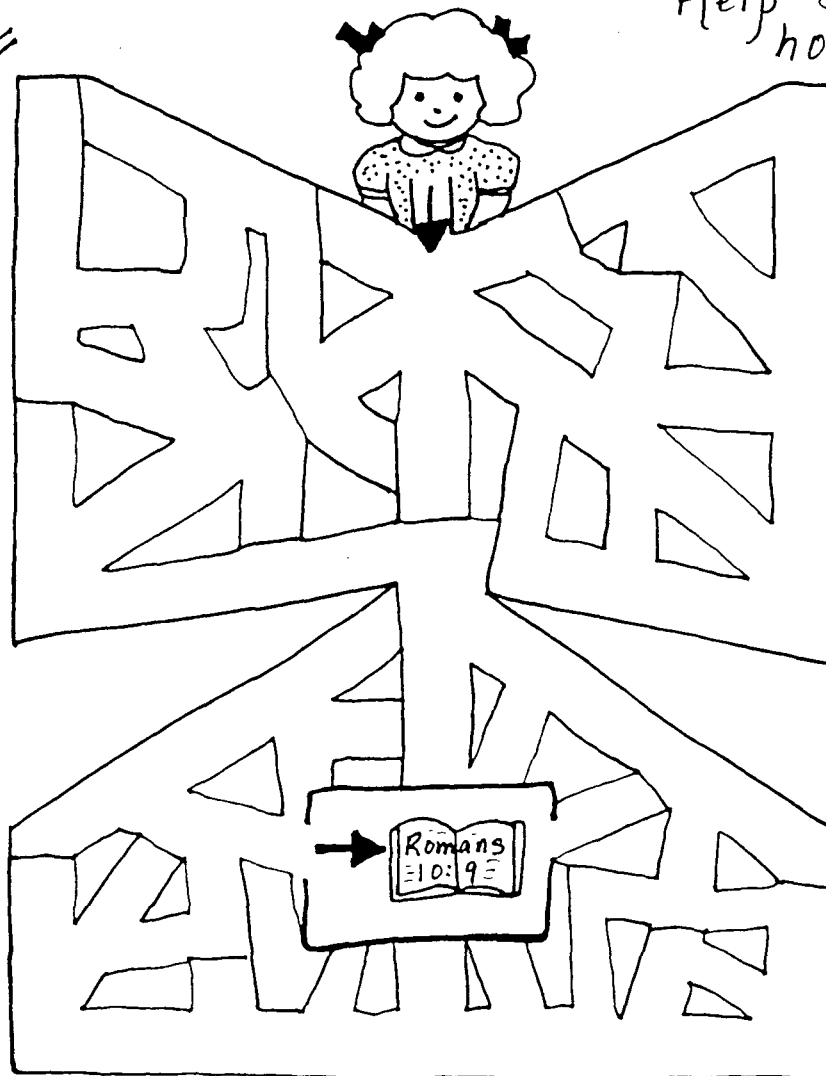
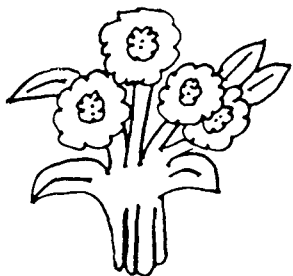
Guess what else is great about holy spirit, Christ in you? It is forever! It is eternal life! Listen to I John 5:11:
