

Dr. Victor Paul Wierwille, his wife Dorothea, and their three children, Donnie, Karen and Mary, are scheduled to leave on a world missionary teaching and training tour from New York City on the ship, Queen Mary, September 21st. Their primary point of interest is India.

Last summer, Archbishop K. C. Pillai, Metropolitan of the Indian Orthodox Episcopal Church of the All India Federation of National Churches, after studying with Dr. Wierwille for a number of weeks, extended an invitation to him and his family to go to India as special Christian ambassadors from America. The purpose is sharing with the East the light on the Holy Spirit and the gifts of the Spirit, plus the secret of power for Abundant Living, the renewed mind, as so clearly set forth in The Word.

The Wierwilles were invited as a family. The East centers its life in THE FAMILY. Since all of Dr. Wierwille's family is filled with the Holy Spirit and all assist him in ministering, the East will respond favorably to such a family and ministry. 

the WOTCL speaks! by DR. VICTOR PAUL WIERWILLE

"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us." Ephesians 3:20.

Power for Abundant Living is available to all who know how to believe and receive. In order to tap spiritual power, we need to know God's part as well as man's responsibility, and viceversa.

Many believers are not manifesting an abundant life and are thus living below Christian par, because they believe God will do for them that which God in His Word so clearly stipulates they must do for themselves. They have been praying amiss and not receiving an answer to their prayers. There must be and is a reason.

There are two things you must know before you can go very far in tapping power for an abundant life. You must know God's Word, which is His Will, to the end of knowing God's part. You must know your responsibility and do it.

Don't ask God to do something for you which the Word says you must do for yourself. God in Christ Jesus through the resurrection, ascension and the giving of the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost, has given us much more than we are claiming.

God "is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think." God's ability equals His willingness. He always wills to do according to His ability. This is remarkable insight.

We often will to do something, but lack the ability to perform. At other times we have the ability but are unwilling. God's willingness equals His ability. On the part of God, His ability and willingness are on a horizontal level with no fluctuation.

It would be wonderful indeed to know His abundance, yet His Word says He is able to exceed abundance for you. "To do exceeding abundantly above that which we may ask or think." Few of us have appropriated and applied our privileges.

"All that we ask or think" is conditioned by His will, which is fully set forth in His Word. You could not ask God to give you a crop without planting or sowing seed. His Word says you must plant first. That is God's will. After you have done that, you may "ask or think" for the "exceeding abundantly".

The "exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think" in and according to His revealed Will is either limited or received abundantly, "according to to the power (ability) that worketh in us".

Abundant living is limited or manifested according to how much we can believe God for. When we walk in great believeing faith, we receive and manifest what we believe.

God in a believer is limited only to the extent that the believer limits Him, "according to the power that worketh in us".

The redemptive privileges extended to born-again believers have not been believed. have too often failed to realize that God in Christ HAS paid it all and made all that He paid for available to all who will believe and act accordingly. Today God is being limited by believers who refuse to act upon what His Word says they must act upon in order to receive and manifest. We wait for God to do it. He has already done it. He is waiting for us to BELIEVE He did it, to accept it, and walk forth in abundance. III John, verse 2.

I finally went back to bed about 4 A.M. (John about 4:30) and went sound asleep. Everyone else seemed scared to death! When I saw the flames, I blessed our house and the car and thanked God for surrounding John and myself with His infinite love and protection.

Then I forgot all about myself and tried to instill calmness in others. Believe me, God surely was with us. We praise Him for His protection and gifts.

Light through an Eastern window!

BISHOP K. C. PILLAI



"And they left all the commandments of the Lord their God, and made them molten images, even two calves, and made a grove, and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served Baal. And they caused their sons and their daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the Lord, to provoke him to anger."

II Kings: 17:16, 17.

Molten images are made of brass, copper and silver. The Eastern people melt the ore and fashion an idol according to their choosing.

Calves used as sacrifices on the altar signify, "We are giving god praise." Therefore, in the Bible, "calves of our lips" means "praising God." This expression equals making a sacrifice to God. A calf is a sacrifice but when it is worshiped, it becomes an idol. Casting idols from molten brass, copper or silver is a very ancient practice, and the idols found near the temples in the East today may have been formed more than five hundred years ago.

In the East two brazen calves are often found before the temples as well as around the gates and beside the holy waters. Each temple has a small pond called a molten sea, and the surrounding walls are made of brass. Calves are sacrificed with the belief that God will keep His people safe and secure. When the people of the East pray, they point to the calves and say, "Lord, the sacrifice which our forefathers made unto thee in the years gone by - we also make unto thee now. Please, Lord, forgive us".

Idols are frequently erected in the midst of a grove. In the Bible a grove is usually a small

plot of ground higher than the surrounding land, on which there are trees that grow quickly and provide shade. These trees that grow and die quickly are known in the Bible as "green bay trees". The eastern people believe that the green bay tree indicates God's presence and is symbolic of God's prosperity and righteousness. Once every six months, during the full moon days, the women go to these groves to cook food and to call upon God, believing His presence is there in manifestation because the groves are green. The true God instructed His people that they were not to worship Him in the groves, but were to cut down the groves and high places, meaning "Don't worship idols, but rid yourself of them by destruction."

In Jeremiah we read that the people baked cakes to the queen of heaven, who is supposed to be one of the goddesses in the stars of the sky. Some stars are also called the host of heaven. According to the superstitution propagated by the priests, the people will suffer a severe plague if they do not have a grand festival in honor of the queen of heaven. Thus many people in the East are subjugated by fear. One of the foremost idols of the groves in the Bible is Baal.

The practice of "fire walking" is not new, but as old as history and as devilish as Satan. Only a devil-possessed person could walk white hot coals of fire without getting burned.

The Mohammedans, who are not supposed to be superstitious or indulge in base practices, have an unusual tradition. Once a year, at the time of the greatest religious festival, they

build a special pit 14 feet in diameter and 4 or 5 feet deep. with an elevated wall 2 feet high surrounding the pit. A few days before the feast they build the fire and keep spreading the red hot coals throughout the pit. On the festival day people walk through the fire to prove that they have not sinned, because they do not get their feet burned. If they have to find out if a man has committed a crime, they compel him to go through the fire. If he gets his feet burned, he is guilty.

God is not pleased with such ungodly practices, and His people are constantly warned not to participate in such devilish acts. God's people are to to be judged by Him and His standards and not according to any of man's ideas. God is a Spirit, and they that worship Him are to worship Him in Spirit and not according to any image or idol. A spirit has no form or comeliness. The true God is the Father of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ.

stipation, severe hemorrhoids, aching back and legs, plus pressure in my lungs and my forehead. The healing was all taken care of in a second, although it took me a week to realize its greatness. This was the first time I saw about eight or nine seated in a healing line, without their uttering a word of their defeats or sicknesses to the one who was ministering. For "V.P." to call upon "average" believers to aid him in the ministering was just too much for me to comprehend. It brought tears to my eyes.

This was the first time I ever saw or heard anyone who could tell you how God operates through man and in man. I learned the difference between being born again and being renewed in mind. I learned how the nine manifestations of the Spirit operate, and for the first time in my life I am just beginning to see the greatness of God and the greatness of His love for both born-again children and for the rest of the world.

Before the class began I was as a wave at sea; now I am as a rock, even if only a tiny one. I am far from knowing all the truths to be had, but I received enough to set me free. To me that is a great accomplishment. Thank God for His deliverance. Now I go to bed with a peaceful mind.

On many previous occasions I have been prayed for, without noticing any particular results. But after "V. P." taught me the receiving was my part, and when he said, "God must do what He says He will do," then I believed and I received. God certainly met me more than half way on that Wednesday night when I was totally healed. Praise His Holy Name! Amen and Amen!

My, oh my, I almost omitted the most important phase of all, which was receiving the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

India, the East and all other places where they will minister.

Boat, train and airplane will be their major mode of traveling. Upon arrival in England on September 26th, they will minister the Holy Spirit and the gifts of the Spirit in that great nation, until October 25th. Since Bishop K. C. Pillai has many friends and hungry hearts in England, he will schedule all of Dr. Wierwille's appointments while he is in the British Isles. On October 25th they will sail from England for Bombay, India, where Rev. J. S. Williams, General Secretary of the All India Federation of National Churches, and Bishop Pillai will receive them and arrange for all classes, plus nightly speaking engagements.

After three months in India, the Wierwilles will sail for Egypt, and thence to Palestine, Greece and Italy. After arriving in Italy, the months of March and April will be spent in Switzerland, France, Germany, Belgium and Holland, including a number of return teaching engagements in England.

The family is scheduled to return to the United States the latter part of April, 1956 aboard the ship U. S. United States.

We believe, and are asking you to join us in believing, that this mission of good will may prove the great spiritual success that Dr. Wierwille and his family want to see achieved.

The truth of The Word of God sets men free, and the Wierwilles know and love Jesus. They long to see souls saved and filled with the Holy Spirit, manifesting the gifts of the Spirit for people's deliverance and for the abundant life in Christ.
