THE FRONT PAGE STORY

The month of May offers us two great days of the Church Year: May 19th, Ascension Day, and May 29th, Pentecost.

For 40 days after the Resurrection our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ appeared from time to time with the apostles and disciples and talked to them regarding the Kingdom of God.

On the 40th day Jesus ascended into heaven to sit down at the right hand of the Father. But, just before He ascended He met with the disciples on the Mount of Olivet and gave them so-called last minute instructions. Last words are always cherished, especially from the lips of a loved one. Among those last words which Jesus shared with His followers we have this instruction, "And behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high." Luke 24:29. "Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth." Acts 1:8. "All Power is given unto me in heaven (the seat of authority) and in earth (the place of execution of authority). Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe **ALL** things whatsoever I have commanded you: (Jesus commanded them as disciples and us as disciples to wait and not go until after being filled with the Holy Ghost) and, lo, I am with

the Word speaks!

Pentecost is the Birthday of the Christian Church. Occurred perhaps on the day of May 28 in the year 30 A.D.

No one was ever born again until the Day of Pentecost. If any one person could have been born again before the substitution of Christ was completely finished, then all could be born again without its completion. Christ's substitution for sinful man was not fully completed until the giving of the Holy Spirit on the day when Pentecost was fully come.

No one ever before received the full fullness of the Holy Spirit, with all NINE evidences of the Holy Spirit in manifestation. In the Old Testament at various times by special appointment of God only, the Holy Spirit was **WITH** people (John 14:17) but **NOW** He was made available to all born again believers to be **IN** them. "And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, (it had been in the process of coming for a long time) they (the number of disciples

in the place at that time) were all with one accord (in unity of spirit and of one purpose) in one place." Acts 2:1. The place was certainly not the so called "Upper Room" as is so generally believed and taught, but it was the Temple, The House of God, called "The House of prayer."

When the phenomenal manifestation of God appeared unto the disciples "it filled all the house where they were sitting." Acts 2:2. The word "house" in this verse has caused most Bible commentators to infer automatically that it was the house of the "Upper Room." But, the Scripture as such does not warrant such a position at all. The Temple was referred to by Jesus as a "House," and according to Luke 24:53 they were continually (meaning daily) in the Temple praising and worshiping God during the ten days following immediately upon the day of Ascension.

There were five daily so called hours of prayer for all sincere believers of God in the

Temple and City of Jerusalem. The hours would correspond in our time to 6 and 9 A.M., 12 Noon, 3 and 6 P.M. According to Acts 2:15 the experience of Pentecost occurred at the "Third hour of the day" which would be 9 o'clock in our time, the hour of prayer. The disciples being assembled together in one accord in the Temple at this hour would not only be logical but spiritually correct and thus it could and was noised abroad quickly and the multitude could gather hurriedly as they did according to Acts 2:6.

Furthermore, I would like for you to note that when the disciples received the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost they were "sitting." Acts 2:2. Not jumping around or shouting, begging or pleading with God, but sitting in worship and praising God.

"And they were all (the about 120 or whatever number of disciples were in the Temple at the time) filled with the Holy Ghost. (Not one of the believers present was missed) and began to speak (they began to speak. I want you to notice who began to speak and who did the speaking. It was not the Holy Ghost, nor did the Holy Ghost force them or push them to speak) **they** began to speak with other

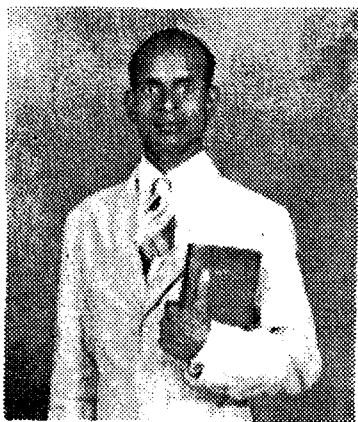
tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance." Acts 2:4. The recipients did the speaking. Speaking is not a miracle. But, **what** they spoke and the **tongue** they spoke in was the miracle. Speaking in an "unknown tongue," is unknown to the speaker but not of necessity unknown to the hearer. It is the external manifestation in the sense world of the internal reality and presence of the fullness of the Holy Spirit. **They** did the speaking but **what** they spoke was "as the Spirit gave them utterance."

To the disciples on the day of Pentecost it was an unknown tongue, but to the Jews from various nations in the world the disciples were understood in their specific language or tongue. Thus, to the hearers it was not tongues, but to the speakers it was. But, to those who heard the disciples speaking in tongues that day and understood it, to them it was prophecy. "And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?" Acts 2:8. "We do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God." Acts 2:11. Thus speaking in tongues must be the speaking of the wonderful works of God.

THE VAN WERT MEMORIAL CHURCH OF INDIA

The November issue of The Way Magazine carried the picture of the Church and congregation. Now we have received the picture of our minister in that Church. Dr. Wierwille will be preaching in the Van Wert Memorial Church of India during his missionary teaching and training tour.

\$300 is needed for this minister's full time salary for this year in the church in India. Join in this direct mission project. Send your check marked India if you feel God would have you to help.

lease from the Van Wert Times Bulletin dated May 9, 1955.

Way off in India there's a "Van Wert Memorial Church."

It bears that name because, for three years, the St. Peter's Evangelical and Reformed Church of Van Wert, Ohio, has undertaken direct support for it and its pastor.

The project is about six months old, which means that for another two and a half years, the Van Wert church will lend its support. After that, the aided church is supposed to have become self-sufficient.

This direct mission project is under the supervision of the Evangelical Missionary Society of the All-India Federation of National Churches, of which the overseer is Archbishop K. C. Pillai of the Madras area, who has spoken several times in recent years in this city.

The Van Wert Memorial Church is located in the village of Kakawalkam, about 25 miles from the city of Madras, in the district of Chingleput, a growing village with some 1,100 people but without a church or a public city well until the Van Wert people decided to help.

According to Dr. V. P. Wierwille, pastor of the local congregation, the project includes the building of the church and parsonage, the digging of a public city well, and the full financial support for an Indian pastor for the three-year period.

Rev. E. John Peter has been assigned by the bishop to serve the Van Wert Memorial Church.

Dr. Wierwille and his family are planning a missionary teaching and training tour this fall which will take them to India for three months, at which time he plans to preach at the Van Wert Memorial Church and also look over other prospective mission fields for the future work of the local church.

Light *through an Eastern window!*

John 16:20, 21

Our Lord Jesus Christ always spoke in Eastern phraseology, "... For joy that a man is born into the world." She is not joyful just because a child is born but because a man is born. The Eastern people are very keen on sons, not that they despise their daughters. Hannah prayed to the Lord to give her a son.

Eastern people pray that the first child may be a son because the son takes the place of the father in the East.

If a man has no sons he adopts a son before he dies, one of his own cast, that he may act as his son legally. That is why many more adoptions take place in the East because of this cultural habit.

When a woman goes into labor she has two problems—mental and physical. She worries because she is afraid the child is going to be a girl. If she has a girl, the relations between her and her husband are strained. They think it is not a good omen to have girls all the time. Therefore, unless a boy is born God's blessing is

not on the family. If it is a girl they just carry a common message to the outside that it is a girl. But if it is a boy they put on a big banquet. They distribute rice to the whole town. They give goods and clothes to hundreds of people. The whole community rejoices. If a girl is born the midwife often keeps it a secret till the mother is strong enough to take the shock for fear she might die.

It is a tremendous joy and blessing to an Oriental family to have a son. A man may give all his wealth to God (the temple) to have one son. He may fast many days, walk miles and miles as an offering of thanksgiving for one son. He may even give much of his property away to God. The rich young ruler who came to Jesus was willing to sell his property, but not to give the proceeds to the poor, because he as an Easterner had been trained to give it to the temple. That is why Jesus told him to sell and give to the poor rather than to the temple.

THE WORLD MISSIONARY TEACHING AND TRAINING TOUR

Dr. Wierwille's tour as a Christian Ambassador from America to India and other nations is rapidly falling into shape.

Dr. R. S. Modak, President of the All India Federation of National Churches and Bishop K. C. Pillai, Archbishop-Metropolitan of the Indian Orthodox Church, recently invited Dr. Wierwille to New York City where for three days they met in special conference sessions laying out the full program and itinerary.

A special Indian dinner at a downtown Restaurant was arranged by Mrs. Modak for Dr. Wierwille in order that leading laymen and clergy might get acquainted with the proposed teaching and training tour.

Dr. A. A. Rouner, pastor of the Cadman Memorial Congregational Church, Brooklyn, and Chairman of the American Committee was one among others who spent some time with Dr. Wierwille.

SEEING THE DAY APPROACHING

A recent issue of Newsweek carried a feature article entitled, "Remaking the Garden of Eden." The country under consideration is now called Iraq. When the Old Turkish Empire broke up and Iraq became a nation, there was the beginning of a prophetic fulfillment so fantastic that Bible students did not recognize it at the time.

One of the most amazing features of prophecy is the return to world prominence, wealth and power of ancient Bible lands. There is no other explanation for many strange statements appearing in the prophecies. Oil is now the main source of wealth, but other minerals are being found. Money is pouring in; Babylon is again becoming the crossroads of commerce. Mighty prophetic fulfillments are in the making.

For two years the President

has carried the burden of a great secret, which has just come out. His acts indicated that he knew something of a very sobering nature. He seemed to think that peace must be preserved at almost any cost.

Now we know. The H-bomb fallout, or radioactive dust, is more destructive to life than the explosion. The wind will carry it over a large area. A threat of immediate war would throw this country into a panic. A sudden forced exit from the big centers would cripple industry almost as much as the bomb itself.

In 1948 he earned his Doctor of Theology degree at Pikes Peak Seminary. During the period from 1944-48, he taught a summer quarter at the Gordon Divinity School in Boston, besides writing a number of books and booklets and contributing various articles to religious periodicals.

He served as pastor of the Evangelical and Reformed Church in Payne, Ohio until 1944, at which time he accepted the pastorate in Van Wert, Ohio.

Dr. Wierwille has a continuously busy schedule as a pastor. He conducts daily radio broadcasts on the "The Hour of Power," publishes the monthly periodical called "The Way," teaches national and international classes on "Power for Abundant Living" and has published books and booklets. By God's continued help and power, Dr. Wierwille will soon have carried the great message of the Holy Spirit into every state in the Union, Canada, Central America, England and the European Continent, plus India, Egypt and Palestine.
