


December News Letter

My Dear Fellow Christians and Helpers of ${f The \ Wav}$

I greet you in the name of Jesus Christ who was God incarnate and whose birthday means so much to us as Christians. I wish that we all might have the joy of being with you in America at this season, but God has seen fit for us to be ministering in this part of the world at this time. We praise His name, as we know you too are doing, for the many doors He has opened to us and the light on the Word which has been shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit.

Our mission in England was such a success that we have organized a branch of The Way at Macclesfield, Cheshire,

England of which Mr. R. Hooley is the Overseer. I just had a letter from him here in India telling me of the success and power of the Holy Spirit in which they are walking since we were with them, and asking us for a three weeks stop and campaign with them before we return to the States from this our Missionary Teaching and Training Tour.

Our mission in India is a wonderful answer to your prayers. You could not possibly even imagine what good has been accomplished, how many souls won for Jesus Christ nor how many were filled with the Holy Spirit. From November 9-18 I taught in Bombay. Then we left Bombay and have been on the road ever since at Kotah 3 days, Ujjain 4 days, Ahmedabad 6 days, Poona 2 days, Ahmedangar 3 days, Sholapur 4 days, Hubli Gudivada 3 days, Hyderabad 2 days, and Madras 4 days. What an opportunity to see the peoples of India on the level of the people in their towns and villages. They are a great peoples with millions perhaps poor in things of this world as we would think

of it, but rich in their spiritual heritage and their great spiritual hunger. Americans have much to learn from these people of the East in the way of tolerance, understanding and love. They gave us a wonderful reception every place we went including the reception where there were many of India's great leaders and scholars. I have been greatly humbled in their presence, for Hindus, Moslems, Jains and many other non-Christians were always in attendance and showed us the greatest of love and courtesy, some things Christians many times don't even show among themselves and especially so among the denominations. I thank God for a privilege of representing Him in this missionary tour and we also thank Him for your wholehearted support of this trip.

I will share with you just one of the opportunities we have had so that you may rejoice with us, for others are in store. At Ujjain I was asked to be one of the two main speakers at the yearly convention of the Jains, an all-Hindu group numbering some three thousand at the convention. I was asked by them, the Hindus themselves, something no denominational missionary would perhaps find offered to them, to speak on The Abundant Life in Jesus Christ. Souls

The Independent Churches and Christians of India have called a mass convention at Travencore, South India, for January 1-10 at which I will be the main speaker. 10,000 to 15,000 people will be in attendance for those days and I do need your prayers that we may do God's best for them in our witnessing to them and bringing them the wonderful light on the Holy Spirit.

God bless you this Holy Season and always, and we know that you won't forget us in your prayers and financially. You will surely stand behind us with your special gifts for the need to do this work here is great and I do need your help.
