

Every place we have gone to share the Word of God we have found great spiritual hunger for the true light on the Bible, not that we have the only true light and that all we have is true, but to the extent that we are built on the Word of God we could not be wrong. But, the people have been so "denominationalized" that they have much "Churchanity" and their hearts hunger for loving, true Biblical Christianity. I have been teaching to hundreds and preaching to many thousands. In addition to all this we have had the privilege of meeting with many of the Governors of the different states of India, as well as the Chief Ministers and others of prominence as offi-

cials both in the Nation, State and Cities. We have been in the outlying Villages where the truest life of the Indian peoples can be seen and understood. Ministering here in India has been the greatest opportunity God has so far opened unto us. Everywhere we go we have been so wonderfully received and the longer we stay the longer they desire for us to remain. This ministry of THE WAY will soon be reaching around the world bringing deliverance to multitudes.

We received many wonderful cards, letters and special love gifts from our friends in the good old U. S. A. for which our thanks have been sent, but our hearts are still warmed, especially since we know that so many are praying for us each day and standing by us in this venture for the glory of God.

Dr. J. S. Williams who is a wonderful man of God here in India, is my constant companion and has done so much for THE WAY ministry in India that I shall never be able to thank him enough. He and I were invited guests to the National Convention of the Jains where more than 10,000 were gathered together from all over India. The Jains are a branch off of the Hindus and their leader is Acharya Shri Tulsi who is pictured in the picture on the front cover as he is listening to my teaching on "The Abundant Life in Christ Jesus." He spent much time with us in private telling us about the whole movement and asking questions of us. Thousands of people would just be thankful for even five words with him, but we had a number of hours together by his invitation, and I can say that he is doing much for the building up of the moral and ethical structure of the Indian peoples. It was here also that we got well acquainted with Professor Krishna Murti the greatest Hindu scholar of India. Our talks about Jesus Christ and our Witness was clear and bright and we thank God for all that was done.

At Ahmednabad 7 different Christian groups banded together, hired a special hall and we filled it night after night, even though there was organized resistance from certain "Christian" groups. Thousands were blessed and many were led to the Lord and also delivered of many diseases including epilepsy, T.B., etc. Letters are almost daily coming to us here yet in India telling of the blessings. Picture A shows Harry Henry, Chairman of the meetings and David Christian the Secretary. We shall never forget those people or the meetings, for after the smoke of the spiritual battle had cleared away, the victory was truly The Lord's. Praise God.

There is so much to be said for the wonderful people of India and their spiritual hunger that only after we write the full report
