By the time the news letter reaches you we will be on our way to Egypt and Palestine. God bless you for your love, prayers and faithful support. We love all of you and will have many wonderful things to share with you when we return. Everywhere we go the blessings of God have attended us and the thousands of people to whom we have ministered. In the South of India we had some 7000 only in attendance at our last meeting and more than 60 accepted Christ and many were physically healed.

At the close of just a few days of meetings in Nagpur the following letter was read by the leader and then given to us. I thought that if you could read the letter yourself it would give you an idea and indicate to you the tremendous spiritual success of our mission. The following is the letter:

I thank God for this joyful occasion which He has very graciously given us of witnessing the spiritual blessings which our Lord God Almighty during the past three days in an United Assembly consisting of members from all local denominations, after a long period of 20 years. Formerly, as some of us remember that members of all denominations in Nagpur used to have combined social and spiritual gathering very often and specially at Christmas and Easter Occasions but such meetings could not take place during the last 20 years.

Thank God that He has again made a beginning of His gathering in these last days by sending His servant Dr. Wierwille and family in our midst who has presented us the pure word of God without mixing up denominational doctrines; with signs and wonders, and we pray that God may

I as Chairman of the reception Committee of Dr. Wierwille party and the free United Christians of Nagpur gathered here this evening the 12th day of January, 1956, thank Dr. Williams, president of the Federation of Independent Churches for bringing about the visit of this great Scholar and expositor of the Bible to our city. The Nagpurians have been very fortunate that they could learn so much from him in such limited time. Dr. Wierwille has not only been able to disclose to us the hidden truth in scriptures but has strengthened and built up many who were weak in their faith. This is the first time in the history of this City that Nagpur has seen last evening and also this evening when the sick which were prayed for received healing. It would not be out of place to mention the great sacrifice that Dr. Wierwille has made so that he could visit our beloved land. He has come to this land at his own expense and without any strings attached to any Mission. We are also grateful to his beloved wife Mrs. Wierwille, she too is a good scholar of the Bible and a spirit filled lady and has been of much help to us during our private Bible studies. It is her sacrifices and her love for the people of India that made her to leave behind her two months old Baby in U.S.A. and accompany her husband in his great evangelical service.

The children are also a real blessing to their parents and are full of love for the Indian people.
