



April News Letter



On the shore of the Sea of Galilee at the foot of the natural amphitheater, where Jesus taught the multitudes as he pushed off shore in a boat. It was here that Dr. Wierwille read Luke 5 as it was originally given by Jesus. The acoustics are so perfect that Mrs. Wierwille and friends 1/5 mile away, and ½ mile way up the hillside could plainly hear each word.

In Nablus, Jordan, about 40 miles north of Jerusalem is the only Samaritan Synagogue and colony of Samaritans, dating back to Bible times. There are only about 350 Samaritans remaining. We arrived in this colony just a few minutes before their Sabbath service. We were invited to witness one of the most unique services. After an hour and a half the head priest, who claims direct descent from Aaron. read for us the oldest Hebrew scroll in existence which is claimed to date back to 4 generations after Aaron. or approximately 3600 years old. It is 25 liters in length. It is kept in a Persian case, and the three knobs projecting above the case represent the tribes of Levi. Ephraim and Manasseh.
