

The HOPE of Christ's Return



The word "hope" in God's Word means something which God has promised that is not yet available. The one promise in God's Word which is NOT yet available is Christ's return. One day Christ is going to return to gather together ALL the born-again believers to live with him FOREVER! What an exciting day THAT will be! Christ's return is also called the "gathering together."

Since only those people who are born again will be gathered together with Christ, how does someone become born again? Romans 10:9 and 10 says that when you confess Jesus as lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you become born again. This is your guarantee that when Christ returns, you will be gathered together with him.

What will happen when Christ comes back? I Thessalonians 4:15 and 16 says: "For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent [come before] them which are asleep. For the Lord [Christ] himself shall descend [come down] from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first."

When Christ returns, not all the born-again believers will still be alive. Those born-again believers who will NOT be alive when Christ comes back are called the "dead in Christ." The first thing God is going to do at Christ's return is to make these believers alive again! I Thessalonians 4:17 tells us what will happen next. It says: "Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."

Those believers who ARE alive when Christ returns will be caught up into the clouds along with the believers who have just been made alive. Together, we will all meet Christ IN THE AIR! I Corinthians 15:52 says that all this will happen "in the twinkling of an eye."


Once we have all been gathered together, nothing will EVER happen again to make us feel unhappy or sad. Everything will be perfect and all of us, as born-again believers, will live together with Christ FOREVER!

No one, except God, knows WHEN Christ is coming back. It will be a great big surprise for everyone! Christ could return in one hundred years, next year or even before you finish reading this page!

There is nothing you or I can do to bring Christ back any quicker than what God has planned. It is like your birthday. You could go to the store and buy yourself a birthday cake, but that would not make your birthday come any quicker. Although we do not know WHEN Christ shall return, we are positive he WILL return because God's Word promises us he will.


Until the day Christ returns, God wants us to believe this promise in our hearts. He wants us to believe the other promises in His Word, too. Let's remember that we are more than conquerors in all we do. Right now we are sons of God with all power! As God's children He will always take care of our every need.


WHO-0-0 is Coming Back?


Let's Learn the Books of the Bible

Romans 8:37:



Bible Match Game



MATERIALS:

construction paper or other stiff paper, scissors, paper bag, pencil, crayons

WHAT TO DO:

- 1. In large letters, write on your paper, "One day Christ shall return." Write each word in a different color crayon.
- 2. Cut out each word.
- 3. Now cut each word into two pieces, so it looks like a puzzle with two pieces to it.
- 4. Put the pieces into a paper bag.
- 5. Decorate your paper bag any way you like. Now you are ready to play the "Bible Match Game!"

HOW TO PLAY:

Shake the bag to mix the pieces and don't look inside! The first player reaches in and takes two pieces. If the two pieces do not match, the player returns the two pieces to the bag and his turn is over. If the two pieces DO fit together to spell a word, the player keeps the pair and scores one point for making a match. Each player's turn continues as long as the pieces he picks make a match. The person with the highest number of points once all the pieces have been matched is the winner.
