

## The Key to Power





### The Key to Power



If you have ever seen someone drive a car, you have probably seen him drive it forward, around corners and maybe even in reverse. The reason the car can move in these directions is because of the powerful engine it has.

If the driver of the car were to park it and take the key out, the engine would stop running. That engine would still have the ability to work and be powerful, but it would not go until someone first put the key back into the car and turned it on. Then, the engine would start again and the car would have the ability to go.

The power God gave us when we were born again works much like the car engine. A person can be loaded with all the power of God on the inside, just like the car with the powerful engine. However, only to the extent that a person renews his mind will this power work in his life. It is the renewed mind that is the key to power.

What does it mean to "renew one's mind"? It means "to hold the Word in mind and act accordingly." Just as when you renew a library book you simply change (make new) the date when it is due, you renew your mind as you simply CHANGE YOUR THINKING. When you renew a library book, you do not throw it away, do you? No. You do not try to throw your mind away either. You simply replace negative thoughts with positive thoughts—the thoughts of God's Word. Since you can only think one thought at a time, as you simply think about God's Word the negative thoughts will go away. Romans 12:2 tells us, "And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God."



Psalms 18:33 teaches us how to "line up" our thinking with God's Word. This verse says, "He maketh my feet like hinds' feet, and setteth me upon my high places."

A hind is a mother deer. When she goes up the side of a mountain with her young deer following her, she tests the ground for loose stones on the slope with her front feet. Then she takes her back feet and places them exactly where her front feet were first placed. If she did not test the ground with her front feet, the loose stones would cause her to fall down the slope and she could die. In the same way, we set our minds on exactly what the Word says. We read what the Word says and then we put those exact same words in our minds and believe them.

Once you become born again by confessing Romans 10:9, you are at that moment a born-again believer, a son of God. At that moment you receive the power of God in you. You are God's child forever. I John 3:2a says, "Beloved, now are we the sons of God." From that moment on you are God's child and He will always be with you to love you and help you.

I Corinthians 1:30 tells us that once we become born again we have the ability to be wise, like Christ was. We can act wisely just as Christ did. We are also righteous. This means that we can stand boldly before God because God has made us perfect spiritually. We now belong to God and He always thinks positively of us. This verse also says we are sanctified, which means that we are set apart to be gathered together when Christ comes back some day. We will then have a new body and live with God forever.

It is God's will that we know and believe these and the other promises to us. When negative thoughts come to our minds, we can quickly replace them with God's Word. How thankful we can be to know God's Word and have the ability to renew our minds. For it is God's Word that tells us the real truth about who we are and all that we can do because we have such a wonderful heavenly Father!



### He Lifted Me


Lord I know I'm born again:


