# The Gift from Him: God in Christ in You



# God in Christ in You

Have you ever looked forward to receiving a gift from someone? If you knew you were going to receive a gift on your birthday, you would be excited about receiving it, wouldn't you? You might even count the days until your birthday, knowing that when your birthday arrived you would receive this gift.

Although birthday gifts are fun, there is a gift God gave about two thousand years ago which is the GREATEST gift that has ever been given to anyone. This wonderful gift was first given on Pentecost. This gift is spiritual seed, called holy spirit, and it is still available today.

In Luke 24:49 Jesus instructed his apostles concerning this gift. Ten days before the day of Pentecost, Jesus told them that he was going to send the promise of the Father. Jesus also told the apostles to wait in the city of Jerusalem until they received this gift which Jesus also called "power from on high," meaning power from God.

Acts 2:1 tells us:

And when the day of Pentecost was fully come [when the day of Pentecost arrived], they were all with one accord in one place.

"One accord" means for the same purpose. The apostles were in the Temple at this time because it was an hour of prayer. The "one place" was the Temple.

Acts 2:2:

And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house [meaning the Temple] where they were sitting.

"Heaven" is any place above the ground. The words "rushing mighty wind" could also be called "heavy breathing." The Temple was also called the house of prayer. So this verse tells us that suddenly there came a sound from above the ground that was like heavy breathing. This heavy breathing was the sound of the apostles breathing.


Acts 2:3 tells us, "And there appeared unto them [the twelve apostles] cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them."

The word "cloven" means split or divided. Seeing "cloven tongues like as of fire" was a special sign provided by God especially for the apostles. God did not promise beforehand that He would do this. Whenever God does more than what He promises in His Word, it is called "phenomenon."

Acts 2:4 tells us, "And they [the twelve apostles] were all filled with the Holy Ghost [holy spirit], and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

This verse says that the twelve apostles were "filled with the Holy Ghost," which means they received the gift of holy spirit from God. When they received this gift, the first thing they did was speak in tongues.

This gift of holy spirit is the greatest gift ever given. It is available to you and me when we simply confess Jesus as lord and believe God raised him from the dead (Romans 10:9 and 10). This gift is "God in Christ in you." With this gift you have the ability to be more than a conqueror. You have the ability to do things Jesus Christ did. The born-again child of God also has the ability to speak in tongues. And you can teach others how to be born again, too!



And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.


