

Dear Parents,


This children's magazine is a publication for you and your children to share as you teach them the Word of God. The story on page 10 provides a background for understanding the significance of the new title—HEIRS.

Listen · Remember · Obey





"Hurry up, Robbie," his oldest brother Chris called to him as he passed Robbie's room. "If you want to ride with me you'd better hurry up!"



And if children, then heirs; heirs of God...


