

Healing Word

Psalms 103:1-5

¹ Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless* his holy name. ² Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: ³ Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; ⁴ Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; ⁵ Who [satisfies] thy mouth with good *things*; *so that* thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalms 1:1-3

¹ Blessed *is* the man [whose]... ² delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. ³ ...he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psalms 23:1-3

¹ The LORD *is* my shepherd; I shall not want. ² He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. ³ He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Exodus 15:26b

...[He] will put none of these diseases upon thee,...: for I *am* the LORD that healeth thee.

Psalms 30:2, 12—31:3

² O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.... ¹² ...end that *my* glory may sing praise[s] [unto] thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.

¹ In thee, O LORD,...I [have] put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness. ² Bow down thine ear to me; deliver me speedily: be thou my strong rock, for an house of defence to save me. ³ For thou *art* my rock and...fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.

⁵ Into thine hand I commit my [soul]: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.

Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart,...

¹³ ...they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he saved them out of their distresses.

²⁰ He sent his word, and healed them,... ²¹ Oh that *men* would praise the LORD *for* his goodness, and *for* his wonderful works [unto] the children of men!

⁴ Surely he hath borne our [sicknesses], and carried our [griefs]:... ⁵ ...he *was* wounded for our transgressions, *he was* bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and with his stripes we [were] healed.

⁸ Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy [rewarder].

1 John 2:1b

...we have an advocate [a defense attorney] with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous [one]:

Ephesians 1:3ff

³ Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in [the heavenlies] in Christ [Jesus]: ⁴ According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation[s] of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: ⁵ Having predestinated us unto [sonship]...by...Christ [Jesus] to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, ⁶ To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us [lovely and acceptable]. ⁷ In whom we have redemption through his blood, the [remission] of sins, according to the riches of his grace; ⁸ Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; ⁹ Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: ¹⁰ That in the [administration] of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him: ¹¹ In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: ¹² That

we should be to the praise of his glory, who...trusted in Christ. ¹³ In whom ye also *trusted*, after...ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with [the holy spirit] of promise, ¹⁴ Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. ¹⁵ Wherefore I also, after I heard of your [believing] in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, ¹⁶ Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; ¹⁷ That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: ¹⁸ [That] the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ And what *is* the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, ²⁰ Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set *him* at his own right hand in the [heavenlies], ²¹ Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: ²² And hath put all *things* under his feet, and gave him *to be* the head over all *things* to the church, ²³ Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

¹⁹ For I rejoice, for I wish you to be wise unto the good, and unharmed by the evil one. ²⁰ And the God of peace shall utterly crush in pieces deeply under your feet quickly.

Psalms 4:6b-8

⁶ ...LORD, lift thou up the light of thy countenance [on] us. ⁷ ...[and] put gladness in [our] heart[s],.... ⁸ I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.

²⁰ Now the God of peace, [who] brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, [the] great shepherd of [his] sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, ²¹ Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom *be* glory for ever and ever.
