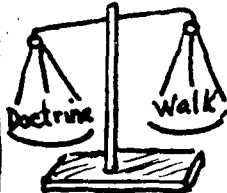
## Leaders' Heart

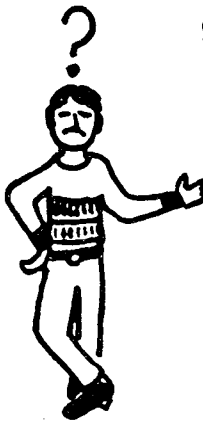
