THE WAY CORPS OBJECTIVES

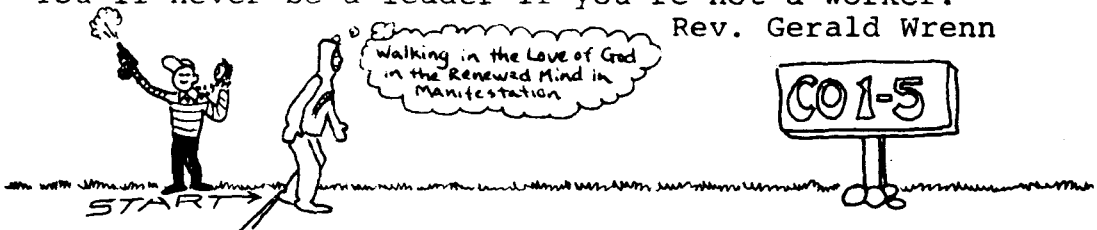
Acquire an in-depth spiritual perception and awareness.

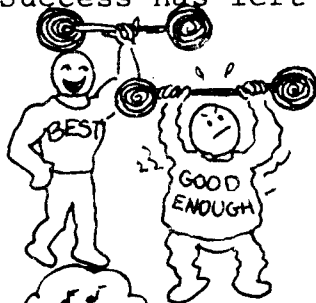
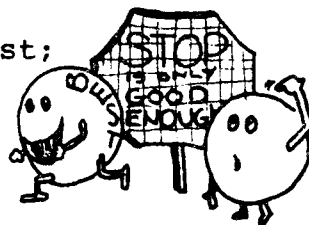


"My son, beware of 'good enough'

 For it is never 'good enough.' "

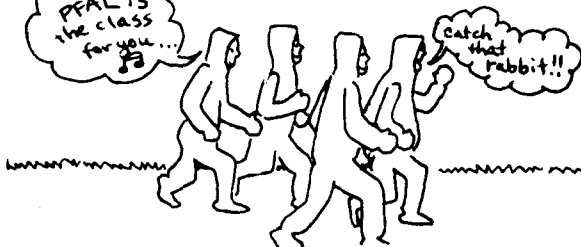


With 'good enough' the shirkers stop,
