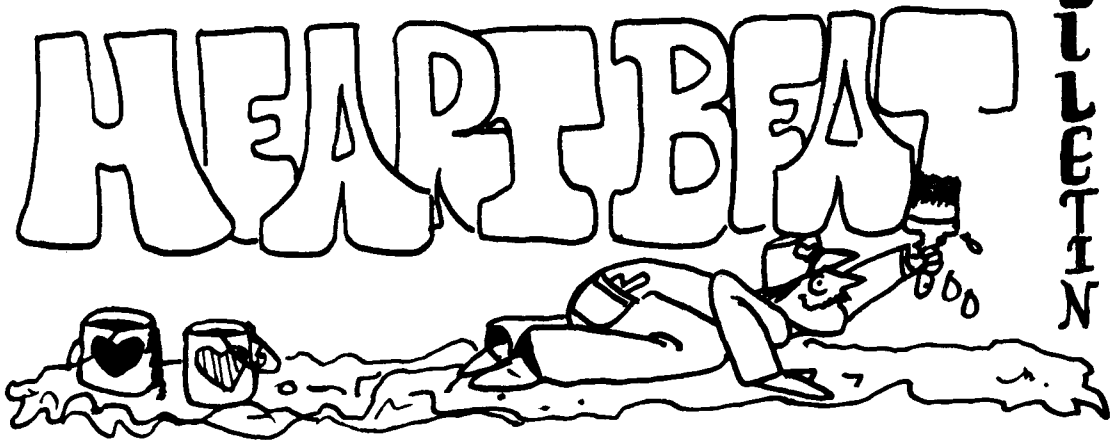

"The greatest commitment ever made was God's to His Word.

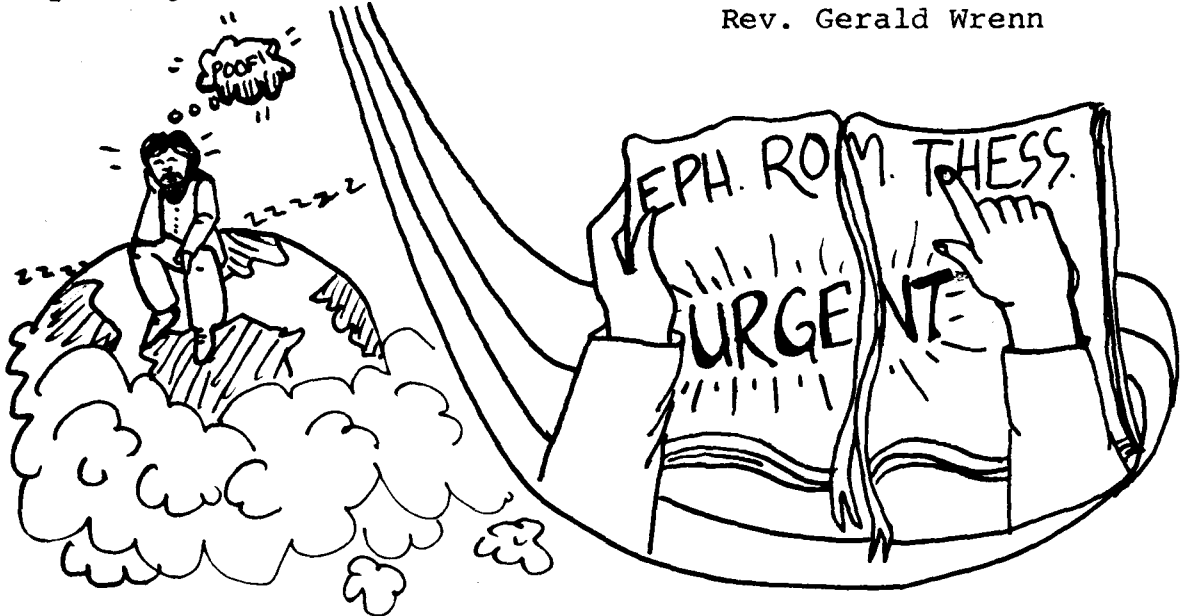
"Christ's life was the whole heart of God.

"The people in the Word aren't 'holier than thou'; they're human. You'll only find the inhuman when you get away from the Word.

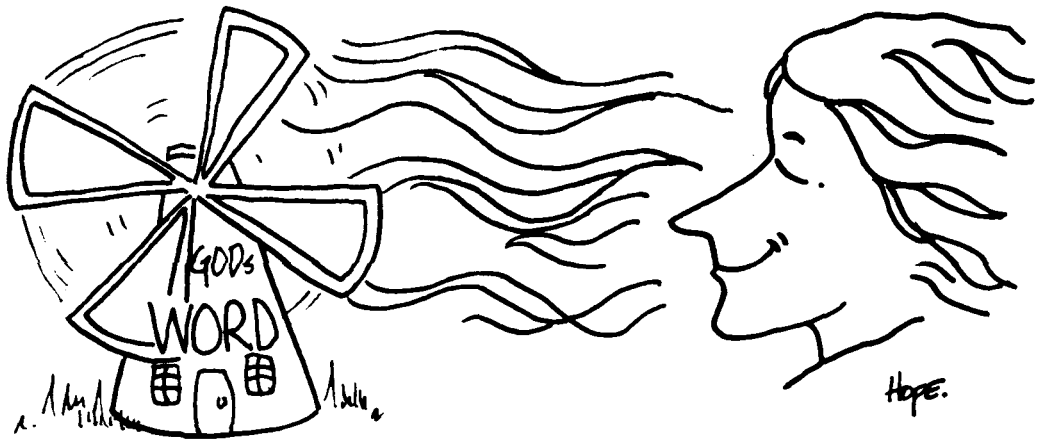
"The urgency of the times does not lie within the world; it's in the Word. It's the challenge to believe now or you might not be here tomorrow."
