peace among ourselves and with all nations.

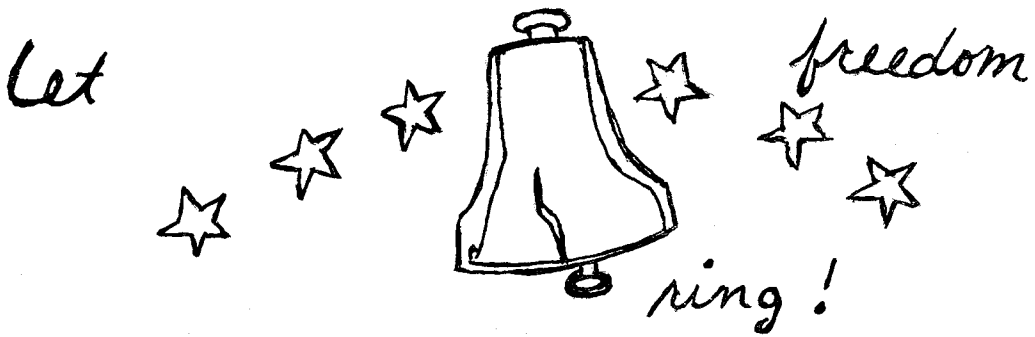
