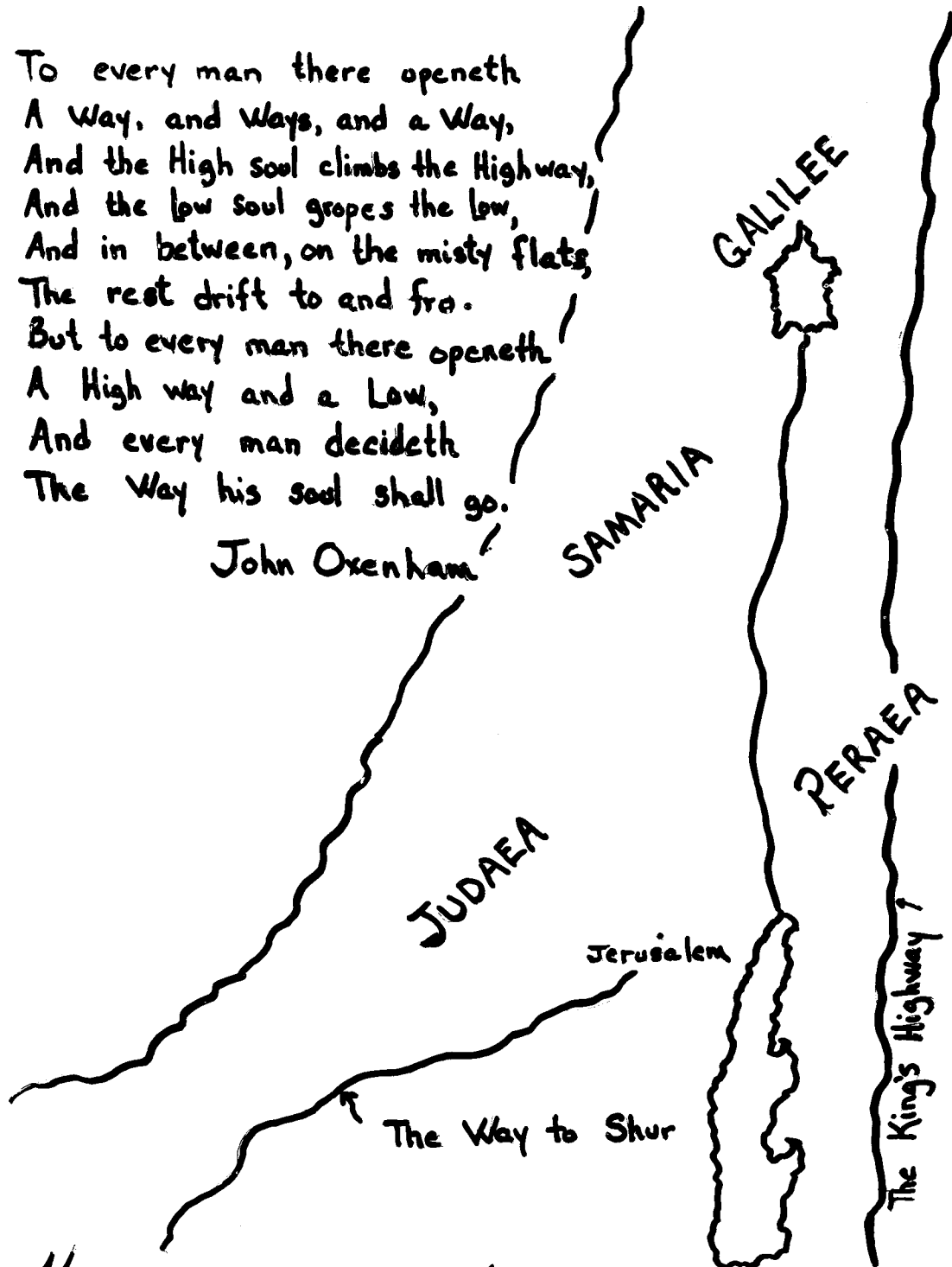


To every man there openeth
