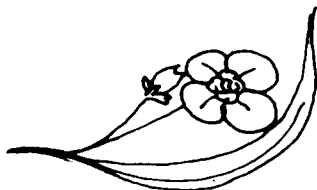
The Way Corps

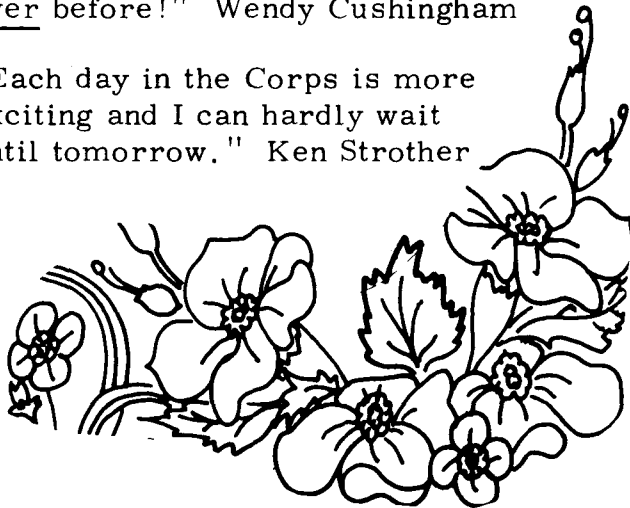

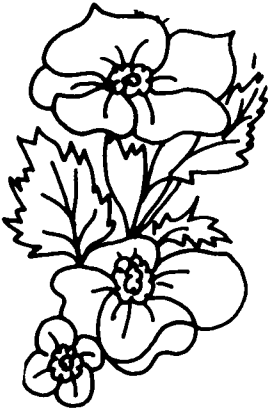
