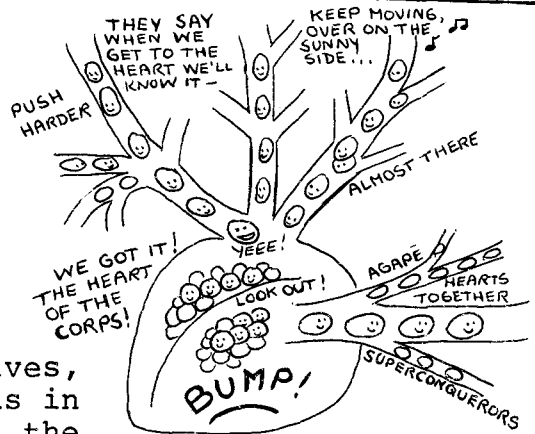


# CORPUSCLES
