## A WOW Vet:

- 1. Daily and faithfully starts the day in prayer (Philippians 4:6). He lifts his family, the leadership of the ministry, his community, etc.
- 2. Tithes and abundantly shares.
- 3. Lives thriftily and reasonably, making the most of his finances.
- 4. Is either part of or runs a hot Twig.
- 5. Is amiable, compatible, and outgoing. He is, as God's Word says, "given to hospitality" (I Timothy 3:2).
- 6. Is versatile at witnessing.
- 7. Carries a "pioneer-type" attitude.
- 8. Speaks God's Word naturally, with ease. He's adept at bringing the truth into conversation.
- 9. Follows this minimum objective: At least once a year to a year and a half, he's undershepherding one person through the Power for Abundant Living series—that means the Foundational, Intermediate, and Advanced Classes. Then, that person is fully instructed.
- 10. Speaks in tongues much. He remembers that he's never helpless when he can pray perfectly (Romans 8:28). Interprets and prophesies consistently and boldly.
- 11. Wins at least one a year to go WOW.
- 12. Supports the ministry by prayer, fellowship, and ideas on moving God's Word.
- 13. Physically, financially, and spiritually supports current WOWs.
- 14. Is "on call" spiritually, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, for emergency or opportunity situations that might come up in his area.
- 15. Is honest in business practices. He is <u>more</u> efficient, <u>more</u> capable, <u>more</u> loving, and cleaner in his business and services than anybody else in the community. And he always gives people what they pay for and more.
