I Thessalonians 1:9,10

Literal according to usage – A translation that reproduces the thoughts and meanings of the original, based on the words of the original according to the verse, context, and remote context and to whom it is written.

Expanded translation – A translation which reproduces the original with alternative meanings and explanatory renderings.

Paraphrase – Gives the gist of the original without corresponding to each word in the original.

I Thessalonians 1:9

“shew” – announce or report

“of us” – concerning us, needed for emphasis.

“entering” – entrance, like the door of utterance (used again in I Thess. 2:1)

I Thessalonians 1:9 – “...how you turned to serve the one true God out from dead idols.”

I Timothy 3:15 “...the church of the living God...”

Anytime a distinction is made between God and the devil the words “living” and/or “true” are used.

I Timothy 4:10 “...we trust in the living God...”

I Timothy 6:17 those of this world trust in uncertain riches.

II Corinthians 6:16 We collectively are the temple; singularly or alone we are the tabernacle.

II Corinthians 3:3 “...written...with the Spirit of the living God...”

Romans 9:2 “...the children of the living God”

Acts 14:8-15 “...turn from these vanities unto the living God...”

I Thessalonians 1:9,10 Work of believing (v9), which earns a crown; “...to server the living and true God...” is the labor of love; (10) is the patience of hope.

Anameno – wait – remain firm.

Ek - from – out from among, from the midst

“heavens” – the Aramaic uses the plural for that which is too immense to describe

“delivered” – rescued

apo – from (different word used here it means away from, motion from the exterior)

“wrath” – that wrath that is coming in the future

Matthew 3:7 wrath to come

Luke 3:7 wrath to come

21:20-28 description of some of the events of the wrath to come

John 3:36 reapers and sewers may both rejoice together

Romans 1:18 the wrath has been revealed

3:5 God takes vengeance (wrath)

2:5-11 the rewards of your works

I Thessalonians 5:9,10 believers are not appointed to wrath but to obtain salvation

Ephesians 5:5 “...no whoremonger nor unclean person nor covetous man who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom...of God”

6:8 good things are received of the Lord

Colossians 3:5,6 the wrath of God comes upon the children of disobedience

Revelations 6:16,17 the great day of wrath is come

11:17,18 this is the description of the day of wrath

16:19 wrath upon the great city of Babylon

19:15 treading the winepress of the wrath of God

I Thessalonians 1:9,10 we are delivered from the wrath

Literal according to usage of vs. 9 & 10

Those who have heard about us from you constantly report how we opened up your area and how you turned to God from idols in order to serve the living and true God. and to await His son (to return) from heaven, whom He raised from among the dead – Jesus, our rescuer from the coming wrath.

I Corinthians 15:6 Jesus Christ goes visiting after he is risen

Psalm 116:15 "Precious" is the word "costly"

6:5 we can't worship or praise God when we are dead

146:4 when you die you no longer have any thoughts

Until you come to the Word and honestly study it you will not know the truth.

Acts 2:25-35 David is not ascended into the heavens

13:34-37 David was laid with his fathers and saw the corruption of the grave

Hebrews 9:27,28 "...appear the second time" look it up. "appear" means to visually see

I Corinthians 15:53-57 death will be swallowed up in victory.
