Dear Way Corps:

God bless your beautiful heart and believing mind as evidenced in your body by its wholeness to walk for Him.

Yes, the Resurrection classes were and are great. To see a dead person get alive spiritually is exciting and a time of great rejoicing. Think of what the angels in heaven do when one is born again. You see, the old man never gets better; he's not just sick nigh unto death, he is DEAD.

The Corps is called to serve above all and anyone. If you're still walking the talk and talking the walk five years after you graduate, there is a good possibility you've caught on. Someone wrote me and said, "It's a long overdue learning for me, that I AM THE CORPS."

*Psalms 20:5:*

*We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the Lord fulfil all thy petitions.*

Corps, get honest with each other—confront each other on walking and talking the Word.

Lots of things are happening. The Devil is really mad and I'm glad. The Devil is using many of his top influential media to offset, hinder, obstruct and destroy the outreach of the delivering truth of God's Word. It reminds me of the New Testament record in Matthew 10:5-16 and Luke 10:1-20. Yes, even the top spirit then had to come down and control people so the Devil wouldn't lose all his adherents.

Yes, even among the Corps there will always be the "Demases" of II Timothy 4:10, for a man's greatest enemies are often in his own household, Matthew 10:36. That really hurts, but it is a neat move on the part of the enemy.

Remember the chorus, "how long has it been since you talked with the Lord" and got someone in the class? Really Corps, you have done so little to have so much. You know, it's one thing to study and teach the Word, another to believe and experience it, then it's no longer mental assent but real life.

If you're on a plateau, called "stalemate," go witnessing, be stubborn on the Word. Deliverance comes when you make the decision to act. Get involved in life and living it. Help make your life available. We never allow ourselves to be conditioned by what people say for we as Corps HAVE the Word, BELIEVE the Word, WALK the Word.

Yes, who is really the wise one? God and those who hear.

*Isaiah 40:12:*

*Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?*

*Psalms 111:2:*

*The works of the Lord are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.*

*Ephesians 2:1:*

*Even also you who are dead to trespasses and sins [verse 5] whom God quickened together with Christ [by grace you have been saved] [verse 4] However, God being rich in mercy, because [on account of] His great love wherewith He loved us, [verse 6] and awakened us up together and made us sit together in the heavenlies in Christ Jesus [verse 7ff].*

Build the wall of the love of God around your heart and all hell can't get in.

*Psalms 34:9:*

*O fear [reverence] the Lord, ye his saints: for there is no want to them that fear [reverence] him.*

Well, I do LOVE you in spite of, but I LIKE you above all when you're a pusher for the Word.

Just a few final thoughts:

Some Corps on the field taking too much time with some people and not sharing their lives equally with others—playing favorites—staying up until 2-3 a.m. with certain ones. No deal.

Position has no special rights or privileges when the wholeness of men's lives is at stake—only a man's function.

History pivots on men who are giants in spiritual and intellectual ability, plus committed persistence and undaunted courage.

World so corrupt, the Word so pure.

Our hearts get hurt meeting apparent failure because our vision is too small. Proverbs 24:10

Be confident in the certainty of your success.

When I cease to be disciplined, I cease to be an athlete.

Wanting to be somebody and do something all your life, then finding out and knowing it is available, is mind blowing.

Tradition is not choice.

Simplify your living and then you'll reduce your expenses.

Never mention or consider circumstances; mention or consider the Word.

The Way is Hisstory in the making.

When a Corps does not get into the Word, and stay there daily, the result is evidenced in that the motivation for serving others becomes one of simply fulfilling directives, sent out or given, so as to stand approved before The Way Corps, etc., etc.

God never set the standard for failure. He set the standard for success (Ephesians 1:9).
