Thus, it may now be necessary for me to place you, if you care to be placed at all, in a position of much lesser responsibility, because apparently I cannot trust you in operating the Corps principles that you are supposed to have so deeply embedded in your life that they are like second nature.



I don't know when I will have the time to write you again, but if not, remember we'll be together at the Rock of Ages, so believe God and walk like you were taught and are being taught in the Corps. God bless.
