Indescribably Delicious

Was your nose inexplicably wriggling this morning when you woke up? It may have been the aroma of omelettes and sausage wafting across the camping area, tantalizing you with the promise of good things to eat.

Since last Wednesday, Food Services has been in full swing, working to provide quality meals and snacks. Huge truckloads of supplies arrive daily, transporting foods from Cincinnati, Sidney, Dayton, Lima, Detroit and even California and Florida.

Food Services includes the preparation of three complete meals daily in our two big dining tents; a Farmers' Market with assorted fruits, nuts, ice cream, cookies, candy and chips; a Snack Shop featuring hamburgers, hot dogs and the like with Drink Stands serving coffee, tea and juices.

Months of preparation are behind the food being served today. For example, Way Builders devised a convection oven, fondly dubbed Nebuchadnezzar, capable of cooking over 3,000 portions at one time. In operation it puts out 1,200,000 BTUs of heat—enough to heat ten small houses at once.

A staff of nearly 1,000 people is involved solely in serving us these wonderful meals. To give you an idea of quantities involved, 2,180 pounds of bratwurst, 766 dozen whole wheat doughnuts and 3,270 cantaloupes were ordered for

consumption during the class.

What will it be today? Chicken cordon-bleu? Tacos? Bratwurst and sauerkraut? French toast? Chef salad? You name it. Our LIVING VICTORIOUSLY Food Services is sure to be serving an appetizing selection of meals and snacks each day.
