Because their third child was less than six months old, Karin Hempel and her husband decided not to attend LIVING VICTORIOUSLY. But last week, Helen Schneider, their Country coordinator's wife, visited them in Bonn. Karin decided at that time to attend the class. She prayed that God would work out the arrangements, as the time to leave West Germany was only a few days away.

"I had no travel money," she said, "no one to help my husband with the children, and an expired passport. Helen prayed with me and then called Andreas Bannat, another believer in Bonn. She asked him to pray for me.

"A little while later she called him back, told him my situation and asked him if he could help me out. I needed more than 1400 marks for expenses. That amount of money was sitting in an envelope next to his phone. He had received it that day. He believed God gave it to him so he could give it to me, as the believers in Acts 4:32 had all things common.

"The first time I asked my mother to help with the children, she said there was no way she could do it. But later she called me back to say she would take care of them during my entire stay in the United States. I had only one day to get my passport because of a German holiday in the middle of the week. What normally would have taken weeks took

only that one day when we went to the U.S. Embassy.

"Within three days of Helen's visit, I was on my way to LIVING VICTORIOUSLY. God had taken care of every detail, and I am so thankful to be here."
