A Letter Home

Dear Folks,

Something woke me up at 3:00 a.m. this morning. I decided it was a good idea to get up, so I slipped out of the tent and walked to the House of His Healing Presence to pray. A couple of other people were there when I arrived, but by the time I'd sat there an hour I was all alone.
